

Request for Docent Guided Tour at the RWP Botanical Center



Docent Tours are available Tuesdays through Fridays (no holidays) between the hours of 9:30AM to 2:30PM. Weekends are very limited due to the number of events being held at the Center. Tours groups of ten or more must be booked at least 4 weeks in advance. Guided tour groups are limited to a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 50 participants (exclusive of chaperones). **Children must be chaperoned at a ratio of 1 adult for every 10 children.** Payments will be made at the Welcome Center as one single payment upon arrival for your tour.

We accept Cash, Check (Please make checks out to City of Providence/ Botanical Center) or Credit Card at the Welcome Center. The Botanical Center is wheelchair accessible.

Fees and Payments for Educational tours

All About Plants Basic Tour

Program duration: 1.5 hour

\$100 up to 25 students, each additional \$4 per student under 12.

\$4 per chaperone. Teacher of the class is free.

**Additional \$1.00 per individual to have lunch on premises.*

All students will learn about plant nutrition, anatomy, and reproduction; observe plant adaptations to our multiple habitats; and understand plant and animal interdependence through pollination and seed dispersal. Direct observations and hands-on activities support concepts throughout for active learning. This tour supports next generation science standards' practices, core ideas, and crosscutting concepts.

All About Plants Tour + Activity

Program duration: 2 hour

\$125 up to 25 students, each additional \$5 per student

\$5 per chaperone. Teacher of the class is free.

**Additional \$1.00 per individual to have lunch on premises.*

Activity will vary based on age group, curriculum and teacher preference. Activity options include: planting a seed; flower pressing; or taking a scavenger hunt.

Ask about special rates for Providence Public Schools. Providence Public School rates do not apply to charter schools or private schools that are located in Providence.

Docent Guided Tours

Adult guided tour groups are limited to a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 50 participants. We can work with you to identify topics of interest to your group from the expertise of our docents. Topics from previous docent guided tours have included:

- General tour and history of the Botanical Center, its greenhouses and the Park
- Basic botany: elementary through college (content varies depending on age level)
- The love life of plants
- How American Plants Transformed English Gardens
- Mexican plants we couldn't do without

\$250 up to 10 people, each additional \$25 per person

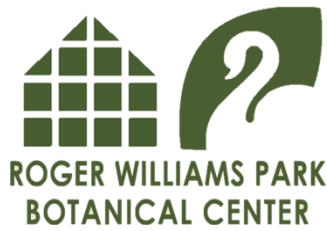
