2021 Socially Distant Enrichment Program Guide:**

1. Creative Arts:

- Children will explore creative arts through music, drama, charades, conceptual ideas and imagination.
- Creative Arts may also include jewelry making, t-shirt design, mosaics, etc.

2. Greeting Card Making:

- Children will create greeting cards that will be distributed to First Responders, Hasbro Children's Hospital, Veteran's Homes, and Nursing Homes.

3. Drawing Class:

- While using pencils, markers, and crayons, children will express their creativity through subject drawing.

4. Creative Writing:

- Children will explore elements of writing through illustrations in creating their own story books.

5. Pictionary:

- Children will draw creative pictures and scenes, while having others guess as to what is being drawn.

6. Painting:

- While using brushes, sponges, and finger paints, children will be creating original artwork and murals by painting on canvas, paper and rocks.

7. Garden Club:

- Children will be planting seeds, growing plants and flowers while maintaining the newly created Zuccolo Youth Garden.

8. Book Club:

- Children will be reading interesting books of their choice.
- Instructors will also read works from various authors to the children.
(*readings will be age and subject appropriate*).

9. Journals:

- Children will write and maintain journals with weekly entries.
- Various topics including current events may be discussed after the weekly entries are written. (*all subjects will be age appropriate*)

10. Poetry Reading & Composing:

- Children will read, compose, and recite poetry.
(*Instructors may also do so.*)

11. Slime Fun:

- Children will have fun in exploring their creativity while making sculptures and artwork with slime.

12. Movie Night:

- Children will watch entertaining movies on a large screen television located in the gymnasium.
(movies will be age and subject appropriate)

13. Homework help

- Students who have homework assignments will receive assistance from qualified staff upon request.

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Kennedy Recreation Center 2021 Socially Distant Enrichment Program Guide:

1. Pictionary:

- Children will draw creative pictures and scenes while having others guess as to what is being drawn.

2. Painting:

- While using brushes, sponges, and finger paints, children will be creating artwork and murals by painting on canvas, paper and rocks.

3. Yoga:

- Children will exercise as part of the Hindu discipline to promote control of the body and mind.

4. Slime Fun:

- Children will have fun creating and making sculptures and artwork with slime.

5. Corn Hole/Table Tennis:

- Children will aim and toss a corn bag 20 to 25 feet, as it makes for good hand and eye coordination.
- Table Tennis can be played with 2 children using a lightweight ball.

6. Storytelling:

- Children can craft their own stories by choosing a hero, an object, a location, and more.

7. Arts & Crafts:

- Children can embrace their artistic side by using hand crafts and ideas such as paper mâché, coloring pages, necklace making and much more.

8. Outdoor Fitness:

- Children will engage in fitness programs such as jumping jacks, running drills, etc.

9. Movie Night:

- Children will watch movies on a large screen television located in are gym.

(all movie will be age appropriate)

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Rogers Recreation Center 2021 Socially Distant Enrichment Program Guide:

1. Garden Club:

- Children will design and educate themselves by planting flowers, vegetables and fruits.

2. Pictionary:

- Children will draw creative pictures and scenes, while having others guess as to what is being drawn.

3. Vision Board:

- Children will display images that represent what they will like to be when they grow up.

4. Painting:

- While using brushes, sponges, and finger paints, children will create artwork and murals by painting on canvas, paper and rocks.

5. Drawing Class:

- Children will create art pieces to display at the center which include drawing, using free hand and or sketches.

6. Slime Fun:

- children will have fun creating and making sculptures and artwork with slime.

7. Creative Art:

- children will create art such as sculptures, videos, film, sound works, printed works, installations, etc.

8. Homework help:

- Children will get staff participation on homework received daily from school.

9. Outdoor Fitness:

- children will engage in exercise and drills etc.

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West End Recreation Center 2021 Socially Distant Enrichment Program Guide:

- 1. Bingo:**
 - Youth will have a game of chance played with cards having numbered squares corresponding to numbered balls drawn at random and may win by covering five such squares in a row.
- 2. Homework:**
 - Youth that have common homework assignments may include required reading, writing, or mathematical exercises to be completed after school and assisted by adults.
- 3. Poetry:**
 - Youth will learn poetry that can become a gateway to other forms of writing. Kids will learn that poems can help you express yourself.
- 4. Board Games:**
 - Youth will choose and partake in board games which come with pieces. The game will be a structured form of play.
- 5. Arts & Crafts:**
 - Youth will have a wide variety of activities involving making things with one's own hands or creating things with pencils, markers, and paper.
- 6. Yoga:**
 - Youth will learn to build strength, awareness, and harmony in both mind and body.
- 7. Movie Night:**
 - Youth will have a night for watching movies together with friends 6ft apart. Movies are selected wisely.

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Batastini Recreation Center 2021 Socially Distant Enrichment Program Guide:

- 1. Painting:**
 - While using brushes, sponges and fingerprints, children will create original artwork and murals by painting on canvas, paper and rocks.
- 2. Book club:**
 - Children will be reading interesting books of their choice learning points for rewards at the end of the week. Instructors will also read works from various authors that are age and subject appropriate.
- 3. Poetry reading, writing and composing.**
 - Children will read, write, and compose poetry. They will use this skill to implement rhyme scheme and iambic pentameter to compose rap and song lyrics.
- 4. Movie night:**
 - Every Friday, children will screen current movies which are age and subject appropriate!
- 5. Arts and Crafts:**
 - Children will create pictures, jewelry, picture frames, etc., using different techniques.
- 6. Bingo:**
 - Children will compete against each other in the game of bingo for prizes. They will be awarded at the end of each round.

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Neutaconkanut Recreation Center 2021 Socially Distant Enrichment Program Guide:

1. Homework help

- Children will receive help on their homework from staff in a quiet controlled environment for better concentration.

2. Arts & Crafts

- Children will artistically express themselves by creating original art through drawing, coloring, painting and paper making projects such as storyboards.
- Arts & crafts also include slime making 101, tie-dye shirts and jewelry making.

3. Girls Club

- Once a week, Girls Club activity will include crocheting 101, jewelry making, painting on small canvases.
- Well also discuss the dangers of social media and internet safety.

4. Games

- Children will have various game options to choose from that include, Bingo, Charades, Simon Says, Scene It, and Boggle.
- Games are encouraged to be played freely or competitively.

5. Poetry Writing

- Once a week, children will learn and compose different types of poems such as Haiku, Sonnet, free verse and rap.
- Staff will help, participate and encourage participants to continue using poetry as a healthy alternative for self-expression.

6. Movies Night

- Once a week, children will watch a movie on a large screen TV in the gymnasium. *(Movies will be age and subject appropriate)*

1. Homework Help

- Students will receive help and encouragement from staff while reviewing homework assignment.

2. Computer Lab

- Computer lab is used primarily for homework then for fun.

3. Reading and Story Telling

- This activity is for younger students. The goal is to reinforce the importance of listening and communicating.

4. Arts & Crafts

- This activity has been well received in the past for all ages. Often, staff will propose an activity. However, some spontaneity is very much welcomed by the participants. Crafts may include pre-packed crafts.

1. Homework Help

- Children will receive help with homework from staff.

2. Game Room

- Children will have access to the game room where they can play games such as, Table Tennis, Air Hockey and Video Games.

3. Math Hoops

- NBA math hoops is a fast-paced game, curriculum, and community program that allows children to learn fundamental math skills while having fun!

4. Arts & Crafts

- Children will be able to use their creative artistic imagination creating art such as, Poster Boards, Painting, Bracelet making and free drawing.

5. Computers

- Children will have access to use laptops with a time limit

6. Graphic Designing

- Children will be able to design pictures, visual content, and interactive designs using computers.

7. Photography

- Children will learn how to take outdoor pictures and use a photo shop program on computers to create new pictures.

8. Yoga

- Outdoor yoga will help children with stretches and breathing

9. Journal writing/ Creative writing

- Weekly entries where children can express their thoughts and feelings. Also, current events and various topics, will be written and shared if they desire.
- Children can write poems, songs, stories, etc., in their creative writing groups.

10. Book Club

- Children will be reading a book of their choice
- Instructors will also read different books to children and discuss the reading of the day.

11. Garden Club

- Children will learn how to plant seeds, grow plants, flowers, and vegetables.

2021 Socially Distant Enrichment Program Guide:**

1. Creative Writing/ Poetry

- Kids will have the opportunity to use their imagination, along with learning basic writing skills. They will create poems, newsletters, short stories, etc.

2. African American History

- Kids will learn and research different African American History, idols, art, inventions, cultures, etc.

3. Tutoring

- Kids will complete homework assignments assigned by their teachers. Students who don't have homework that evening will strengthen their math or English with worksheets provided by us.

4. Rock painting

- Kids will paint different patterns and pictures on rocks.

5. Home Economics

- Kids will learn basic, important everyday skills such as sewing clothes, hygiene procedures, ironing, etc.

6. Art-N-Crafts

- Kids will be exploring different type of art projects. They will learn to create vision boards, collages, tie dye, beading, etc.

7. Movie Night

- Kids will watch a movie of their choice as a group every Friday 6-8pm.
(movies will be age and subject appropriate)

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Sackett Recreation Center 2021 Socially Distant Enrichment Program Guide:

1. Drawing:

- The students will be given a prop/picture to draw. This skill will help improve their creativity and detail in drawing.

2. Painting

- Will be abstract, using various colors to express imagery through colors to express emotion.

3. Poetry

- Children will read and write poetry and then transpose it into their modern-day vernacular.

4. Garden club

- Children will learn horticultural skills as to what plants grow in different types of soil. Children will also do seed planting of flowers and vegetables.

5. Spelling bee

- Children will learn 25 words a week, and they will be able to define, spell correctly and then use in a sentence. At the end of the month, the students will compete against each other and the winner will be given a prize.

6. Clay molding

- Children will create sculptures of animals, buildings, etc.

6. Puzzles

- Children will put together a 100-150 puzzle pieces. They will compete with other children to see who completes the puzzle first, the winner will be given a prize. This skill will sharpen the students shape recognition.

7. Lego building

- Children will use their imagination to construct and build multiple things by using Legos. This will help strengthen their fine motor skills.

- Children will acquire an appreciation of art and expression. They will be challenged to think and then interpret it in their own drawing as to how they would have drawn the same pictures either by drawing or verbal expression.

1. Homework Help

- Homework help will take place in the gym and community room. Children will be separated according to grade level.

2. Arts and Crafts

- Will consist of Drawing/Painting and small craft projects.

3. Bingo

- Bingo will take place in the gym children will have their own personal chips and board.

4. Table Tennis

- Will take place in the gym, children will have their own balls and paddles. *(equipment will be cleaned after each game.)*

5. Outdoor Track and Field

- Will take place at Hope High School on the 400 Meter track. Children will social distance by grade level using two ideas of the track.
