

1994:

- Fred Lippitt, Chair of the Providence Plan, creates
 Woonasquatucket River Greenway Project (WRGP), to help revitalize Olneyville
 - ✓ Most economically challenged neighborhood in PVD
 - √ No safe parks
 - √ 60% of people do not own cars

1998:

- Woonasquatucket River designated an American Heritage River
- **2001:**
 - Woonasquatucket River Watershed Council (WRWC) created





2001:

First on-road segment of Greenway completed from Providence Place to Valley Street

2006 - 2014:

- Kinsley Ave to Lyman Ave in Johnston off-road sections completed
- Buttonhole Golf Course off-road
- Eagle Square off-road
- Donigian Park off-road
- Woonasquatucket Adventure Park off-road

Today:

- 75 acres of parkland created along river
- 6 well used public parks created or revitalized
- 7 miles of on-road/off-road Greenway in Providence and Johnston
- Invasive plants managed on all 7 miles
- Red Shed Bike Camp teaches 100 kids to ride on Greenway every summer
- Leveraged over \$120M for Greenway, Parks























Corridor History:The Woonasquatucket Vision Plan (2018)

- Enhance and Maintain Public Spaces








Scope and Schedule
































GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE KEY:


