## Paper Plate Flamingo


## Supplies needed for flamingo craft:

- 1. Construction paper
- 2. Paper plate
- 3. Tissue paper
- 4. Popsicle sticks (4)

## Flamingo craft directions:

- 1. First step is to color your paper plate (preferably pink but you can use any colors you would like).
- 2. Trace your hand on the tissue paper, make sure there are a few layers of tissue paper so there will be multiples when you cut it out.
- 3. Cut out the tracing of your hand.
- 4. Then, take a glue stick and layer on the tissue hands so it covers most of the paper plate acting as the flamingo's feathers.
- 5. Next, color your Popsicle sticks, these will be the flamingo's legs. Put these aside for the time being.
- 6. Now, to create the flamingos head you can use my cutout that I made or feel free to make your own! Make sure the neck has an "s" shape and a long black beak. I recommend using a heavier style paper so the head stands straight up and won't fall. Then tape the head to the back of the paper plate, placing it where you would like.
- 7. Finally, tape your 2 colored Popsicle sticks to the back bottom of the paper plate, opposite side of the head. Tape or glue the remaining 2 Popsicle sticks to the bottom of the other sticks, one on top of the other creating the long-extended legs of the flamingo.

Now enjoy! You can even stick the flamingo into a potted plant as a decoration if you like!
