Make a Paper Plate Deer with Handprint Antlers



Materials:

Paper plate
Brown paper
Black paper
White paper
Brown crayons
Glue stick



Directions:

Trace your hands on the brown paper and cut out your hand prints.










Color the front of the plate. Fold in the bottom edges and color these as well. Glue the edges down to the center of the plate to form a point at the bottom.

Cut 3 small circles from the black paper. One will be the nose the other two will be eyes. Cut 2 slightly larger circles from the white paper. These will be the other part of the eyes.





Glue one black circle on the bottom of the point, for the nose. Glue each other black circle onto a white circle, then glue them to the top section of the plate for eyes. Finally glue your cut-out handprints at the very top on the back of the plate for antlers!
