### Handicap Parking Street Signs Request

A residential handicap parking signs are signs that designate a parking space as “disabled” and only useable by the person who holds the relevant residential handicap parking permit.

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

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You must meet the following eligibility requirements to request a residential parking sign in front of your house:

1. You must be a resident of the City of Providence
2. You must have a valid handicap parking placard; AND
3. You must live in either:
  - a. A multi-family building.
  - b. A single-family home with no driveway or off-street parking at all.
  - c. A single-family home and your driveway causes a true hardship to use for parking, such as:
    - i. A slope that is steeper than 8%
    - ii. Extremely uneven ground
    - iii. The driveway is significantly far away from an entrance to your home

#### **Required Documentation:**

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At the time of the application, you must provide the following information and/or documents:

1. Your name
2. Your address
3. Your phone number
4. A copy of your valid handicap parking placard

#### **How to Apply:**

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Eligible applicants can apply either by
