Dear M. Thompson,

I write on behalf of the Fox Point Neighborhood Association (FPNA) regarding Brown University's application for a dimensional variance at 126 Power Street, which is on the docket for the ZBR meeting this evening at 5:30pm. Would you be willing to pass on our opinion, below, to the Board?

FPNA supports the construction of a house at the intersection of Power and Brook streets, which is proposed by Brown University for the gravelly plot adjacent to the eastern-most of two large residence halls currently under construction and abutting the Power Street residential area. We believe a house will shelter the historic residential neighborhood from the newly built dorms, the design of which we and a coalition of neighbors and other neighborhood groups opposed in 2020 and 2021. We appreciate this important concession to neighbors, and hope Brown will be excused from zoning restrictions in order to move forward with it.
