

Sheep Craft

Supplies needed:

1. Construction paper
2. Toilet-Paper Roll
3. Cotton Balls
4. Chenille Sticks and/or Popsicle Stick
5. Adult Supervision



Instructions:

1. Using glue or tape, cover your toilet-paper roll with as many cotton balls as you want. Let it dry depending on what kind of glue you used.
2. Cut out the sheep's head using the template provided or make your own. Don't forget to draw the face on! Add some cotton balls to the top of its head too.
3. If you want to use the popsicle stick for your sheep, you must first add its arms to the sides of the toilet-paper roll using tape or glue.
4. Then add its head to the top of the toilet-paper roll using tape or glue.
5. Finally, securely tape the popsicle stick to the inside bottom of the toilet-paper roll. Your sheep is ready to stick into a potted plant or outside in the garden!
6. If you want to use chenille sticks for its legs instead, first turn the toilet-paper roll sideways and stick the sheep's head to one of the sides using tape or glue.
7. When that is done, tape on your chenille stick legs to the underside of the toilet-paper roll and your sheep will stand up on its own. Place it anywhere you would like!
