Subject: Providence Community – Police Relations Act 4th Quarter Report

Effective January 1 2018, Municipal Ordinance known as the Providence Community-Police Relations Act (PCRA) went in to effect. Accordingly, there are certain quarterly requirements under “Section (I) Accountability and enforcement” that the Providence police Department needs to prepare and make available to the Providence External Review Authority, the public and the city council.

Subsection (iii). Complaints received by the Office of Professional responsibility involving alleged violations of one or more provisions of this ordinance.

From January 1st (2020) to April 1st (2020) we have received the following complaints that fall under the reporting requirements of the PCPRA:

- A Compliant was received of refusal to provide name and badge number. The office of Professional responsibility investigated and found no evidence to support the complaint. Complainant was contacted and complaint was withdrawn.
- A complaint was received for an illegal vehicle stop. The office of Professional responsibility investigated and found no evidence to support the complaint. The complaint was withdrawn.
- A complaint was received for an illegal vehicle search and stop. The office of Professional responsibility investigated and secured BWC footage of the incident. The investigation revealed justifications for the officer's actions. The civilian complaint process was explained to the complainant who resides out of state. Complainant stated he will contact this office at a later date if he decides to go forward with the complaint. Complainant was also advised that hearing dates will be pending the status of the Covid-19 crisis.
