- Conversations and meetings with neighborhood stakeholders
  - Parking availability
  - Speeding
  - Pedestrian safety



## **Project Timeline Going**

Forward

- Prioritized pavement, sidewalk and drainage improvements
  - Expected 2023-2025
- Parking lots
  - Construction possible starting as soon as 2024
- Shared Use Path Connector
  - Construction possible starting as soon as 2024
- Speed lumps
  - Expected construction 2023
- Westminster Street Improvements
  - Construction possible starting as soon as 2024
- Valley/Broadway/Westminster intersection
  - City pursuing funding. Engineering possible 2024, construction to follow
  - Construction dates contingent upon public/private development projects

- Numerous public/private development projects occurring in and around the Dike Street Area
- Public Development:
  - US-6/10
  - Pedestrian Bridge/Ramp
- Private Property Developments:

# Expected 2023-2025

- Prioritized City streets within project limits are proposed to receive mill & overlay
  - Drainage issues may warrant more extensive repairs
- Roadway construction by DPW will be prioritized based on condition
  - Failed Condition: Bough Street & Atwood Street
  - Poor Condition: Oak Street, Service Road, Stokes Street, Hartford Avenue, Plainfield Street, & Westminster Street
  - Fair Condition: Edna Street, Magnolia Street, Troy Street, Dike Street, &



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## **Drainage Improvements**



- Drainage structures will be cleaned and flushed
- Notable Flooding Locations:
  - Hartford Avenue at Rt. 6 Off-Ramp
  - Hartford Avenue & Atwood Street Intersection
  - Magnolia Street at Agnes Street
  - East End of Dike Street
  - Stokes Street at Westminster
    Street
  - Troy Street between Magnolia
    Street & Oak Street

#### Sidewalk/Pedestrian

#### Improvements

- Construction Timeline: Expected 2023-2025
- Highest priority due to extreme deterioration or no current existing sidewalk
  - Atwood Street, Magnolia Street, Agnes Street, Oak Street, Dike Street, and Troy Street
- Remaining sidewalk improvements throughout project site will be completed based on further prioritization/available funding
- ADA compliant wheelchair ramps & bump out locations along with improved roadway striping are proposed to further improve pedestrian accessways












## **Parking Concept**




- Phased construction possible as soon as 2024
- Designed to avoid clearance issues with US-6/10 overhead
- Upon completion of US-6/10, RIDOT will install lighting on underside of US-6 for safety
- Close to 80 available spaces between the 4 parking bays



#### Shared Use Path: Alternative 1A

DIKE STF

- At-Grade, off-road path connecting Dike Street to Pilsudski Street
- Width: 10 ft
- At-Grade Length: 900 ft
- Proposed Lighting:
  - 12-foot decorative City standard poles and luminaires





## Shared Use Path:

#### AAYOR JORGE O. ELORZA CITY OF PROVIDENCE

- At-Grade, off-road path connecting Oak Street to Pilsudski Street
- Width: 10 ft
- At-Grade Length: 650 ft
- Proposed Lighting:
  - 12-foot decorative City standard poles and luminaires




### **Shared Use Path:**



#### Alternative 2 • Pedestrian


- Bridge/Ramp to At-Grade, off-road path ending at Pilsudski Street
- Width: 10 ft
- At-Grade Length: 580 ft
- Ramp Length: 160 ft
- Proposed Lighting:
  - At Grade Portion: 12-foot decorative poles similar to Alt 1A & Alt 1B
     Ramp (2 options):
    - Option 1: Luminaires



### **Shared Use Path:**

### Alternative 3

- ADA compliant ramp to At-Grade, off-road path ending at Pilsudski Street
- Width: 10 ft
- At-Grade Length: 390 ft
- Ramp Length: 320 ft
- Proposed Lighting:
  - At Grade Portion: 12-foot decorative poles similar to Alt 1A & Alt 1B
    - Ramp (2 options):
      - Option 1: Luminaires mounted along underside of milling


Lighting decorative City standard poles and luminaires

#### Troy Street Improvements & Traffic Calmin


- Construction timeline: Expected 2023
