Residential Handicap Parking Street Signs Request

Residential Handicap Parking signs are signs that designate a parking space as accessible only for people who hold a disabled parking placard.

Eligibility Requirements:

You must meet the following eligibility requirements to request a Residential Handicap Parking sign in front of your house:

- 1. You must be a resident of the City of Providence and live at the address where you are requesting handicap parking signs
- 2. You must have a valid Disability Parking Placard issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV); AND
- 3. You must live in either:
 - a. A multi-family building.
 - b. A single-family home with no driveway or off-street parking
 - c. A single-family home with a shared driveway
 - d. A single-family home where your driveway or off-street parking is inaccessible for you. Examples of this are:
 - i. Driveway too steep for car to utilize
 - ii. Driveway too narrow to get from your car to your home's entrance
 - iii. Extremely uneven ground
 - iv. Driveway is significantly far away from an entrance to your home as compared to street parking

Required Documentation:

At the time of the application, you must provide the following information and/or documents:

- 4. 1. Your name
- 5. 2. Your address
- 6. 3. Your phone number
- 7. 4. A copy of your valid Disabled Parking Placard

How to Apply:

Eligible applicants can apply either by
