The briefing report addresses the following requirements under:

Subsection (i) Complaints received by the Office of Professional Responsibility

Ordinance 18 1/2-4(i)

C. "Complaints received by the Office of Professional Responsibility involving alleged violations of one or more provisions of this section."

Complaints received between July 1st – September 30th, 2023.

On 8-15-23, a male subject filed a complaint stated an officer reached for his property and he did not give a consent to be searched. The subject was operating an electric scooter. Investigation revealed an undercover officer working with a statewide task force that was conducting surveillance on a location, observed the complainant wearing a hooded sweatshirt with the hood up and carrying shoulder bag commonly used to carry firearms. The officer detained the citizen and conducted a "terry pat" on the bag, never opening the bag. This office called the complainant on several times, never being able to make contact, or receive a return call. The subject lists his address in Bronx, NY.

On 8-23-23, a male subject filed a complaint stating that on 2-15-23 he was illegally detained, assaulted and arrested while he was doing nothing more that walking on a public sidewalk. Investigation reveals that officers were responding to a call of a breaking and entering in progress and detained the complainant walking by the scene. This case is pending a formal civilian complaint hearing.

On 8-28-23, a male subject filed a complaint stating he was stopped in traffic in Olneyville when a Black infinity with Massachusetts plates pulled in front of him and a white male exited and approached him. At the same time, a Navy-Blue Ford F150 with unknown plates pulled up behind him and more white males from the truck approached him. The subject states all males were in plain clothes and had firearms on the right hip and he believed them to be police officers. He states he was removed from his vehicle and his car was searched. A review of the master list of police undercover vehicles reveals that this department does not have a Navy-blue Ford F150 in the fleet, nor does the department have a black infinity with Massachusetts plates. Further, a check of radio transmissions for the time and date of the stop was conducted and was absent a car stop by undercover detectives.







