

Request for Youth Educational Field Trip at the RWP Botanical Center

Field Trips are available Tuesdays through Fridays (no holidays) between the hours of 9:30 AM to 2:30 PM. School groups are limited to a maximum of 50 participants (exclusive of chaperones). School groups of 25 or more will be **semi-self-guided with multiple docent-led learning stations to visit** throughout the indoor and outdoor gardens. **Children must be chaperoned at a ratio of 1 adult for every 10 children.** Payments will be made at the Welcome Center as one single payment upon arrival for your trip. We accept Cash, Check (Please make checks out to the City of Providence/ Botanical Center), or Credit Card at the Welcome Center.

- \$125 up to 25 students, each additional \$5 per student. Maximum of 50 students.
- Chaperones and Teachers are free.
- Additional \$1 per student to eat lunch on premises (Lunch NOT Provided).
 - *Ask about special rates for Providence Public Schools. Providence Public School rates do not apply to charter schools or private schools that are located in Providence.*

Flowers + Pollinators (Grades K-2) <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Program duration: 1.5 hrs. Teaches students important terms and concepts related to basic structure and function of the parts of a flower, the role of animals in pollination and methods of seed dispersal.	Plant Adaptations (Grades 3-5) <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Program duration: 1.5 hrs. Helps students understand why and how a plant species may adapt or change over time in ways that aid its survival.	Ecosystems (Middle school – Highschool) <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Program duration: 1.5 hrs. Explores the symbiotic relationships between organisms and the biotic and abiotic influences to which they respond and adapt.
