Nathan Bishop Monumental Sign Questions

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1. Do you have a reference image for the signage to have an idea of the requirement?
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The City's response is as follows:

1. Attached is a reference image which shows one possible type of design based on brick which would match the bare minimum aesthetic aspects of the design (base incorporates brick, sign area is primarily the changeable letter portion, and I superimposed the school name and mascot logo). However this is just a very basic example based on an existing sign elsewhere, it need not be copied, the City is open to any design which meets the criteria laid out in the RFP.



2. The City is looking for a sign based on brick for this project. A brick base meets the aesthetic goals of our city buildings, so while we are open to a broad range of different styles and designs including brick, any design submitted for this project should incorporate brick in the base design.
3. This requirement is a general one for all City of Providence municipal construction projects. However, since the extent of the on-site work for this sign is at most pouring a small concrete pad, there aren't any project specific licenses required for this work.
4. The goal of this project is for the new sign to be built and installed by the winning vendor by the start of the new school year in September.
