

PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Providence Department of Housing & Human Services, Division of Housing & Community Development, is seeking public comment on its draft FY 2026 Annual Action Plan, which describes the City's proposed use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) funds for Program Year 2026.

The draft FY 2026 Annual Action Plan will be available for public review and comment for a 30-day period beginning **06/30/26** and ending **07/29/26**. During this time, the public is encouraged to review the draft Plan and submit written comments.

The City is also providing public notice of amendments to prior Annual Action Plans. These amendments consist of revisions to previously approved projects that do not constitute substantial amendments under the City's Citizen Participation Plan. A summary of the proposed amendments is available for public review during the same comment period.
